Additionally, Christopher A. Ferry, Esquire shall perform duties under the direction of the Chief Judge, in accordance with Rule 12.491, *Florida Rules of Family Law Procedure*, and other applicable Florida statutes ad rules.

The appointment of Christopher A. Ferry, Esquire shall take effect July 26, 2021 and shall continue until further order of this court.
