COURT HOLIDAY CLOSURES – 2024**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to SCPR 4.07 the courts are mandated to close for business in observance of certain holiday events; and

**WHEREAS** the undersigned Chief Judge is authorized to designate certain other dates for closure during each calendar year; it is

**ORDERED** that:

1. The Courts of the First Judicial Circuit will be closed to the public the following calendar dates in the year 2024:

Monday, January 1, 2024, New Year's Day  
Monday, January 15, 2024, Observe Martin Luther King's Birthday  
Friday, March 29, 2024, Good Friday  
Monday, May 27, 2024, Memorial Day  
Thursday, July 4, 2024, Independence Day  
Monday, September 2, 2024, Labor Day  
Thursday, October 3, 2024, Rosh Hashana  
Monday, November 11, 2024, Veterans Day  
Thursday, November 28, 2024, Thanksgiving Day  
Friday, November 29, 2024, Friday after Thanksgiving Day  
Tuesday, December 24, 2024, Christmas Eve  
Wednesday, December 25, 2024, Christmas Day

2. Pursuant to §43.26 and §43.27, *Florida Statutes*, all Clerks of the Courts in the First Judicial Circuit must provide appropriate staff in support of the Clerk's official duties and

responsibilities to the judicial processes when courts in the First Judicial Circuit are open to the public for business.
