It is impossible to imagine a free society without these individual liberties, yet historical and current debates surrounding them continually challenge us to consider their boundaries and resilience. Changes in technology have reshaped how free speech and free press work in the everyday world."

- 1. Minimum of **750 words but no more than 1250 words**, double spaced, and conforming to Times New Roman font size 12, with a one-inch margin on all sides.
- 2. Minimum of one primary source and two secondary sources. Primary source should be in addition to the U.S. Constitution. All references and sources must be cited appropriately.
- 3. The **2019 Law Day Essay Contest Cover Sheet** completed in its entirety and attached to the front of the student's essay.

- 5. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS: MONDAY, May 6, 2019.
