

Technology Roadshow – Friday, November 1

PENSACOLA, Fla. – October 23, 2019 – The Florida Bar Young Lawyers Division and the Escambia-Santa Rosa Bar Association will host a Technology Roadshow on Friday, November 1. The roadshow seminar will cover recognizing and addressing common security threats in a law firm, understanding metadata and ethical responsibility with legal documents, how a Practice Management Program can prevent malpractice claims, and securing mobile devices.
