Child Support Services

On August 30, 2021, child support services, previously located at the Theodore Bruno Juvenile Justice Building (JJC), were moved to the Family Law division, 2nd floor, in the MC Blanchard Judicial Building. Previously known as Domestic Relations, the new Child Support department has been incorporated into Family Law division in order to provide parties, attorneys and agency partners easier access to clerk personnel and the opportunity to take care of all child support related matters at one location.

Change to Friday Business Hours

Beginning Oct. 1, 2021, business hours for all Escambia County Clerk's offices will be as follows:

Monday – Thursday	8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
Friday	8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

As a reminder, certain processes require additional time for the clerk and the judiciary to complete. Those specific processes include domestic violence and protection for vulnerable adult injunctions, Marchman Act and Baker Act petitions. We recommend in-person filings for these case types be initiated one hour before close of business to allow sufficient time to process.
